Letter to donors

Dear Friends of Angel Charity for Children, Inc.,

For 35 years Angel Charity has been Tucson's "Halo for Hire". Thanks to the partnership with our committed donors, we have funded over \$26 million to improve the lives for more than one million children in our community.

In this, our 36th year of making miracles, we found that requests for assistance from organizations that provide services to children was overwhelming. Since the needs were great, we did something we have never done before: commit funding to eight amazing agencies.

In addition to funding seven small grants totaling almost \$200,000 which will immediately benefit over 1,600 children, Angel Charity has committed to fund Tucson Village Farm to construct a much needed Culinary Education Center. This building will house a certified teaching kitchen and education space. Once built, over 18,000 children each year will learn skills which will enable them to maintain a healthy diet and lifestyle and create change in their own lives, families and communities. Pediatricians are waiting for this center to be built so that they can refer 9,000 patients to this "farm"acy.

Please assist us in creating a space that will teach children new habits and skills necessary to prevent childhood obesity and diabetes by partnering with us this year. We hope when you read about the projects we are presenting for your consideration you will join us on our continuing journey to change the lives of children in our community.

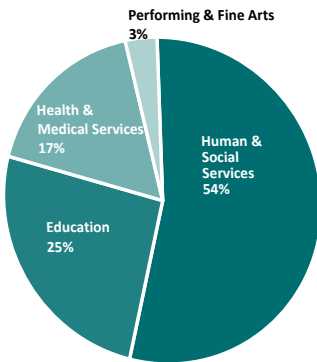

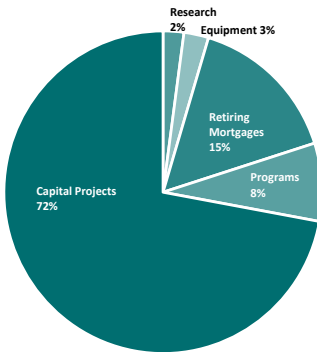

Who we are

Angel Charity for Children, Inc. is a non-profit organization comprised of 150 devoted members representing a cross-section of the Tucson community. Through innovative fundraising, these dedicated and effective Angels are committed to providing Pima County's children with the vibrant future they so richly deserve.

Founded in 1983 by Tucsonan Louise Thomas, Angel Charity for Children, Inc. retired the mortgage and expanded and remodeled the Ronald McDonald House in its first year of working miracles. Each year since then, a thoroughly researched, tax-exempt children's agency (or multiple agencies) benefits from the year-round fundraising program.

Why donate?

- We emphasize funding a one-time capital expenditure that retires a mortgage, remodels or renovates an existing structure, or constructs a new facility.

- Our beneficiary selection process includes a detailed application, multiple presentations, a thorough and professional analysis of financial statements, and a site visit to help ensure each beneficiary is a viable, sustainable entity.
- A variety of children's needs are considered for funding regardless of race, gender, religion, sexual preference or national origin.
- Arizona ranks among the lowest in the country for funding human services. Your contribution will help us move up in the ranks by ensuring the longevity of local agencies that provide much needed services for our most vulnerable population.

Tucson Village Farm

Amount to be funded: \$445,000

Project Description:

Tucson Village Farm offers year-round, hands-on agriculture and nutrition-based programs for youth of all ages, as well as programs for the community and families. They serve urban youth from all socio-economic backgrounds and focus on those who are low-income and at-risk. They teach children about the importance of maintaining a healthy lifestyle and help them develop leadership skills that empower them to create change within their own lives, families, and communities. In 2017, Tucson Village Farm delivered 44,851 hours of direct programming to 12,913 Pima County children.

Tucson Village Farm was selected by Angel Charity to receive \$445,000 to building a Culinary Education Center for Children that will enable them to safely teach 18,000 + kids/year how to prepare healthy meals from fresh food and provide the education and scaffolding they need to create brighter, healthier futures. Having a teaching kitchen on site is the last slice of the Village Farm programming “pie” to help them to truly carry out their seed-to-table mission; in addition to providing a tremendous resource for children and families across Tucson, the kitchen will bring in revenue through the sale of value-added goods and rental of the space, ensuring that Tucson Village Farm remains a sustainable resource for the children of Pima County for many years to come.



Small Gifts

Candlelighters Childhood Cancer Foundation

Amount to be funded: \$6,760

Candlelighters is a parent run organization that educates, supports and advocates for families of children with cancer and other blood disorders as well as bereaved families and survivors of childhood cancers.

Candlelighters was awarded \$6,760. Funding will be used to create a more functional and up to date website that will allow the organization to interact with more families of children with cancer.

First Tee of Tucson

Amount to be funded: \$30,000

The First Tee is an international youth development organization introducing the game of golf and its inherent values like integrity, respect and perseverance to young people. Through after school and in school programs, they help shape the lives of young people from all walks of life.

First Tee was awarded \$30,000 to purchase mobile canopy shade structures to allow more children to participate in this educational program.

Gabriel's Angels

Amount to be funded: \$35,000

Gabriel's Angels delivers healing pet therapy to abused, neglected and at-risk children. Their goal is to instill in children an overall emotional sense of well-being, safety, and happiness. They provide pet therapy services to 122 partner agencies free of charge and serve over 14,600 children annually through 170 registered Pet Therapy Teams.

Gabriel's Angels was awarded \$35,000 to deliver pet therapy in school through animals. The Animals, Books and Children (ABC) program will help over 100 at-risk children increase their literacy.

More Than a Bed

Amount to be funded: \$50,000

More Than A Bed is a resource center for foster and adoptive families. They connect families with the basic resources they need such as beds, clothing and underwear to help foster children and their families.

More Than a Bed was awarded \$50,000 to purchase beds, dressers and underwear for foster, kinship and adoptive families that host children in their home.

SAAVI Services for the Blind

Amount to be funded: \$25,000

Southern Arizona Association for the Visually Impaired (SAAVI) has been working with blind and visually impaired people since 1964 and serves over 2,000 clients per year.

SAAVI was awarded \$25,000 to fund Saturday and after-school programming for blind children to learn academic and life skills and to purchase 10 Braille displays.

SARSEF

Amount to be funded: \$28,824

The mission of SARSEF (Southern Arizona Research, Science and Engineering Foundation) is to create Arizona's future critical thinkers and problem solvers through science and engineering.

SARSEF was awarded \$28,824 to provide year-round critical thinking and problem-solving based education programs to low income youth vulnerable to science and math learning loss.

Tucson Soccer Academy

Amount to be funded: \$20,000

Tucson Soccer Academy ("TSA") seeks to provide the best possible learning environment and overall experience for the players in its programs through its relentless commitment to excellence and by demanding the highest standards of conduct.

TSA was awarded \$20,000 to fund scholarships for registration fees for low income youth soccer players who learn valuable moral and life lessons through competitive soccer.
