### **Angel Charity Launches T-Shirt Campaign to Thank Frontline Workers During COVID-19 Crisis**

#### ***“Not All Angels Wear Halos”***

**(TUCSON, AZ - April 21, 2020)** — Local nonprofit Angel Charity for Children is encouraging the public to thank and acknowledge the heroic efforts of frontline workers during this COVID-19 crisis through a T-shirt campaign that declares “Not All Angels Wear Halos.”

“This is an opportunity for all of us to honor the many angels among us who are working tirelessly to keep our community stay strong and safe,” said Adriana Rincon, Angel Charity’s 2020 General Chair. “Imagine the positive lift you would bring as you wear the T-shirt or even better, gift this T-shirt as a thank you to a medical professional, first responder, restaurant or grocery store employee, delivery person and so many other essential business employees who are sustaining all of us during this challenging time.”

The “Not All Angels Wear Halos” T-shirts are \$20 each, or \$15 each for five or more, and includes shipping and handling. Orders can be placed at [AngelCharity.org](http://AngelCharity.org) while quantities last.

According to Rincon, 100% of the net proceeds will benefit Angel Charity’s 2020 beneficiaries that serve the needs of children in Pima County. Materials and services to produce the T-shirts were donated by Garment Graphics, a local promotional products company, and their partners. Graphic design was provided by Leslie Perls and Noah Walker.

“Like most nonprofits today, our beneficiaries are struggling during this COVID-19 crisis to maintain services with reduced budget and staffing. Our goal is to ensure the future remains bright for children in Pima County by helping provide our 2020 beneficiaries with the funding they need to continue serving their constituent families,” said Rincon.

Angel Charity’s 2020 beneficiaries include Intermountain Center, Reid Park Zoo, Amanda Hope Rainbow Angels, Boys To Men, Jewish Family & Children’s Services (JFCS), Literacy Connects and Make Way for Books.

An all-volunteer organization, Angel Charity is the single largest nonprofit in Tucson dedicated specifically to raising funds to benefit children in Pima County. Since 1983, Angel Charity has provided nearly \$28 million to fund 87 local agencies providing social services, medical research and treatment, arts and education for children.
