### **Angel Charity to Award Grants Up to \$100,000 to Agencies Serving Children in Pima County *January 18 Deadline for Online Applications***

(TUCSON, AZ December 21, 2020) – Nonprofit agencies serving children in Pima County are encouraged to apply for grants from \$10,000 to \$100,000 to be awarded in 2021 by Angel Charity for Children. Deadline for online applications is January 18 with funds to be awarded by April 30.

With funding more urgent now than ever to help provide quality care and services for children, Angel Charity is streamlining and conducting its grants process entirely online, forgoing its traditional in-person presentations. Applicants must serve children age 18 and under in Pima County Arizona and hold a nonprofit tax-exempt status for a minimum of three years.
